CLBI Financial Aid Application

We believe that every young person deserves the opportunity to attend CLBI. As such, we are proud to offer our students a number of scholarships and bursaries, all of which are made possible by the generous donors and supporters of the school.

• Start your CLBI Financial Aid Application

- Visit <u>clbi.edu/admissions</u>, scroll to "Financial Assistance", and click the CLBI Financial Aid Application thumbnail.

Who can apply?

- The CLBI Financial Aid Application is open to all students for whom at least 1 of the following options applies:
 - a) currently attending CLBI
 - b) currently applying to CLBI
 - b) currently accepted to the upcoming CLBI school year.

How much can you expect to receive?

- Each submitted CLBI Financial Aid Application receives a **minimum of \$500***, but is eligible to receive **up to \$5000***. (*towards your CLBI tuition)

Note: Amounts received will be applied to your full year's tuition at CLBI. 50% will automatically be applied to the 1st semester (Sep-Dec). To apply the remaining 50% to the 2nd semester (Jan-Apr), recipients are to have maintained all classroom requirements and been an active member in the community at CLBI.



Early Application Discounts

These discounts are granted to students who complete and submit their CLBI application by a specified date. These discounts include:

• Standard Early Bird Discount (\$500 off tuition)

- Applies to all applicants who completed and submitted their application (for the upcoming school year) by the last day in February of that year.

• Event-Related Early Discounts (designated amount)

- Applies to all applicants who attended a designated CLBI event and also completed and submitted their application by the specified date (ex: CLBI Open House, Youth Surge, etc.).

Other Benefits to Applying Early

- Provides time to plan and figure out finances
- Lowers stress and/or anxiety with confirmed fall plans
- Allows CLBI Admissions Department time to provide all necessary information for the upcoming school year.



Student Referral Discounts

These discounts are granted to students whose names are included in other students' applications as a referral.

• Student Referral Discount (\$500 off tuition/per referral)

- For each application that includes your name as a referral, you receive \$500 off your tuition.
- The above discount is limited to one referral name per application (if multiple referrals names are listed in an application, the above discount will apply only to the first name that appears on that list).
- An individual can be listed as a referral in multiple applications, thus receiving multiple referral discounts (while also abiding by the guidelines listed above).

Other Benefits to Student Referrals

- Provides students the opportunity to directly support their fellow students with a tuition discount.
- Encourages friends or family to apply.
- Reinforces the supportive nature of CLBI to a new student.



Scholarships & Bursaries

We desire to help CLBI students be made aware of the various scholarships and bursaries that are available to them. This includes, but is not limited to:

CLBI Scholarships & Bursaries

- Applications are made available for students during

 November of the first term and are awarded in December.
- Available to all students who submit their Scholarships & Bursary application by the given deadline and meet the criteria of respective scholarship/bursary.
- Allocation of all Scholarship & Bursary amounts is agreed upon and approved by the CLBI Student Aid Committee.

Grants & Loans

Each year, Alberta Student Aid provides students with a number of grants and loans. CLBI students have received upwards of \$4,000/yr of grant money towards school expenses.

- Applying for ⁴Alberta Student Aid (Alberta residents only)
 - Your single application automatically gets you considered for Alberta Student Loans, Canada Student Loans, and Grants.
 - **Step 1)** ⁵ Begin your Alberta Student Aid Application
 - Step 2) Choose one of following to apply for:
 - a) Loan & grant money*
 - Fill out application & enter requested amount of \$1 (*All loan applications are automatically considered for grants)
 - b) Grant money only
 - Fill out application for grant money
 - Enter requested amount of \$1

Support Request Letter

Sending out a CLBI Support Request Letter is a practical and personal way to seek out support needed to attend CLBI. While your supporters most likely won't be attending CLBI alongside you, they fill a vital role of providing support that will allow you to participate in all that CLBI has to offer.

What is a CLBI Support Request Letter?

- A personalized letter that you write and send out that asks recipients to support you as you attend CLBI.

Who do I send it to?

- Family members, close friends, and others with whom you have a close relationship with.
- Your home church and/or any other churches, schools, or faith communities you've attended or are connected with.

How do I write it/where do I start?
